### Seeing Is Not Believing

**John 6:32** Jesus said, "I assure you, Moses didn't give them bread from heaven. My Father did. And now He offers you the true bread from heaven. <sup>33</sup> The true bread of God is the one who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."

<sup>34</sup> "Sir," they said, "give us that bread every day of our lives."

<sup>35</sup> Jesus replied, "I am the bread of life. No one who comes to Me will ever be hungry again. Those who believe in Me will never thirst. <sup>36</sup> But you haven't believed in Me even though you have seen Me. <sup>37</sup> However, those the Father has given Me will come to Me, and I will never reject them. <sup>38</sup> For I have come down from heaven to do the will of God who sent Me, not to do what I want. <sup>39</sup> And this is the will of God, that I should not lose even one of all those He has given Me, but that I should raise them to eternal life at the last day. <sup>40</sup> For it is My Father's will that all who see His Son and believe in Him should have eternal life — that I should raise them at the last day."

<sup>41</sup> Then the people began to murmur in disagreement because He had said, "I am the bread from heaven." <sup>42</sup> They said, "This is Jesus, the son of Joseph. We know his father and mother. How can He say, 'I came down from heaven'?" NLT
