A. A dinnertime lesson

1. Presenting His **devotion** for us
2. Presenting the **demonstration** for us
  - a. What was going on with the **disciples**?
  - b. What was the dramatic **picture**?

- It was a parable about His **mission**.

- It was a parable illustrating our **daily** need for **cleansing**.

3. Presenting His **direction** to us

- a. He taught by **example**.
- b. He taught that we were to be **DOERS** not just **HEARERS**.
